“The Protestant Church of Germany: Past and Present”, Instructor Ken Rogers, the course will be in June 2011. Preliminary details: includes a trip to Marburg, Germany, 12-15 days in length. Approximate cost: \$2,000.00 including airfare. Cost dependent on fluctuations in the Euro and oil prices. Marburg is built on a steep hill, so participants need to be in good physical condition and have a valid US passport. While this course will include some church history, its major focus is on the cross-cultural experience. Most of the time will be spent in Marburg, with a one day excursion to a number of places including Schwarzenau where the Church of the Brethren as we know it began. Participation will earn TRIM students 2 units of credit, and CEU participants 4 CEUs. Registration deadline will be in December 2010.
